Admissions Requirements

Middle Years Programme

- 2.0 or higher in all academic subject
- 2.0 or higher in conduct
- Acceptable Effort (1s and2s)
- Demonstrate grade level performance on the FSA
- Submit an application online (parent portal) or by U.S. Mail or Visit: www.miamimagnets.org

All applicants must be screened for admission to the magnet program. If accepted, he/she will be enrolled as a full-time student at the school of acceptance. Students must demonstrate acceptable performance (as determined by school site policy) in order to remain in the magnet program.

Acceptable progress in all academic and conduct areas must be maintained. If a student earns a "D" or "F" in any subject area or conduct he/she will be placed on academic probation for the next nine week grading period. If all academic grades and conduct grades are not acceptable he/she will be administratively transferred to his/her assigned middle school.
