



North Dade Middle School IB Middle Years Programme Admission Policy

Application Process:

Our application process balances the principles of accessibility with need to ensure student readiness and parental support. All interested students shall be encouraged to apply-- and all students with special educational needs shall be accommodated. Prior to the application process, information regarding the IB Middle Years Programme will be widely disseminated.

Special Education (SPED) IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) recognizes that students come from a variety of cultures, backgrounds, and have a range of academic, physical and other needs. There are many students who may have a recognized, special educational need; other students may have special needs that have not yet been diagnosed.

All applicants must be screened for admission to the magnet program. If accepted, he/she will enroll as a full -time student at the school of acceptance. Students must demonstrate acceptable performance (as determined by school site policy) in order to remain in the magnet program. Acceptable progress in all academic and conduct areas must be maintained. If a student earns a “D” or “F” in any subject area or conduct, he/ she will be placed on academic probation for the next nine -week grading period. If all academic grades and conduct grades are not acceptable, he/she will be administratively transferred to his/her assigned middle school.

- 2.0 or higher in conduct • Acceptable Effort (1s and 2s)
